Our students are as usually very good in playing an important role in the morning assemblies...... Just take a look at our SVISTIANS performing the best in the morning assemblies.




















House Wise Bulletin Boards

These are decorated on a theme –'How to develop Positive thinking.










LIVE LIFE: (Leader In Me)


Under this directive, SVIS, Hyderabad enthusiastically organized various competitions, speeches, debates, quiz and other activities for the realization of the programme.














Colour Day: Green - The Colour of Life
