Innovative Learning

SVIS promotes child-centric learning through the Chrysalis Curriculum for Classes I-V and the ThinkRoom Program, focusing on cognitive, emotional, and social development. Foundation classes for Grades VI-X strengthen core concepts, while the Integrated Programme for Grades XI-XII prepares students for competitive exams such as IIT-JEE, NEET, and EAMCET.

Experiential learning is enhanced through smart classrooms, digital resources, and the Atal Tinkering Lab, where students explore robotics, electronics, and 3D printing, promoting innovation and STEAM education.

At the Regional Level (Vijayawada), Shireesh Kumar of class 9 and Harsha Sai of class 8 won 3rd Prize (₹20,000) for their project "CP-Alert: Prevention of Sandalwood Deforestation," while Nimish of class 8 and Eshanth Reddy of class 9 received an Appreciation Award (₹8,000) for "Virtual Historian: 3D Scene Reconstruction."

SOF OLYMPIAD
